

Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities 4 new youth cases have been reported at the McLennan County campus

September 29, 2020

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 4 Youth at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- As of today, TJJD has administered 1,473 COVID tests to youth.

Since the start of the pandemic, 181 staff members at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 56 Gainesville State School: 11 Giddings State School: 43

McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 28 Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 43

Since the start of the pandemic, 206 youth at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 31 Gainesville State School: 13 Giddings State School: 89

McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 47 Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 26
