

## **Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities**

November 13, 2020

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 1 member of the medical staff at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- TJJD has administered 2,272 COVID-19 tests to youth since the start of the pandemic.

Since the start of the pandemic, 211 staff members at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 65 Gainesville State School: 13 Giddings State School: 45

McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 41 Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 47

Since the start of the pandemic, 242 youth at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 44 Gainesville State School: 13 Giddings State School: 89

McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 69 Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 27
