



Population of State Secure Facilities (ADP)





Diversions (Cumulative) – 266 in FY19





## Executive Summary

During FY 2019, violence and disruptive behavior inside the five TJJJ secure juvenile correctional facilities remained a priority of the OIG. Despite the reduction in the overall population, the number of OIG investigations of violence directed against staff increased from the previous year. However, the number of incidents resulting in Worker Compensation claims and the overall costs has declined, though the costs per incident increased slightly. The Special Prosecutions Unit took a record number of OIG criminal charges filed into consideration, as a part of case management and final case dispositions (plea bargains). Of the 67 TJJJ offenders convicted of felonious conduct, primarily for assault on public servants, 45 were sentenced to prison terms in TDCJ. While in TJJJ custody, those offenders were involved in 1,612 incident reports involving restraints or use of force by TJJJ; 10,110 incidents of disruption; 5,724 security referrals; and 2,103 Level II violations.

## LEGISLATIVE PERFORMANCE MEASURES

### INCIDENT REPORTING CENTER

Established by the Legislature, the Department operates a 24-hour hotline to take complaint calls from the juveniles, family, and staff of juvenile facilities and programs in Texas. This is operated by the OIG, and is staffed by TCOLE certified telecommunications operators. As with previous years, the total number of state, county, and contract calls received by the IRC continues to increase.

### CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS

Also established by the Legislature, the OIG is charged with the responsibility of investigating criminal activity at state and contract care facilities, by juveniles, staff, volunteers, and contractors. The overall number of investigations decreased slightly from FY 2018, though the number of arrests stemming from those investigations increased significantly in FY 2019.
