Rule: Insurance Coverage

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ACA Standard(s): 3-JTS-1B-03, 1B-16, 3A-25

Policy.

- (1) The Texas Youth Commission (TYC) complies with state statutes which protect its employees from losses.
 - (2) TYC offers group life, accident and health insurance to its employees pursuant to Texas Insurance Code, Article 3.50-2.
 - (3) TYC provides workers' compensation insurance to its employees pursuant to Texas Labor Code, Section 501.001 et. seq.
 - (4) TYC indemnifies employees, pursuant to Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Chapter 104, for certain negligent acts of employees for which they may be held liable.
 - (5) TYC does not provide an insurance policy of collision insurance against the negligent acts of its employees while operating state-owned vehicles. The State of Texas and TYC are "self-insured" and all claims for automobile-related damages are filed under the Texas Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Chapter 101. Claims are filed through the Tort Litigation Division of the Attorney General's Office.
 - (6) TYC bonds certain employees as permitted by Texas Government Code, §653.001 et. seq.–
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
