(a) **Policy.**

The State Volunteer Resource Council for Texas Youth (SVRC) is a nonprofit corporation established to support and sustain the network of affiliated community resource councils that provide resources to the youth in TYC. The SVRC members consist of officers and delegates from local councils. The SVRC aids in communication between local community councils and the executive/administrative staff of TYC; promotes volunteer services and fund raising for local needs and programs; and promotes the establishment of local community resource councils in communities where TYC programs exist.

(b) **Procedures.**

(1) The manager of volunteer services will:

- (A) establish and sustain the SVRC consistent with VLS.05.01;
- (B) provide support and assistance to the SVRC in soliciting donations, preparing reports, and carrying out business objectives; and
- (C) notify the SVRC treasurer regularly of the donations received.

(2) The SVRC will:

- (A) meet at least two (2) times each year;
  - (B) comply with all fiscal responsibilities as outlined in VLS.05.05;
  - (C) maintain a bank account to support state council activities;
  - (D) make financial transactions in accordance with the Texas Nonprofit Corporation Act; and
  - (E) co-sponsor the annual statewide volunteer conference in partnership with TYC.
