## Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

December 31, 2021

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- One youth at a halfway house tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- One youth at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- Four youth at the Gainesville State School tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- Three Youth Development Coaches at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, have tested positive for COVID-19 since last night.
- One staff member and one Youth Development Coach at Evins have tested positive for COVID-19 since last night.
- One staff member and one Youth Development Coach at the Gainesville State School tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- One staff member at a halfway house tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- At this time, TJJD has 108 active cases across its facilities.
