**TJJD to Suspend Transfers From County Facilities Where Staff or Youth Have  
Tested Positive for COVID-19  
The Executive Director Order Affects Dallas, Harris, and Bowie Counties**

April 2, 2020

AUSTIN—TJJD Executive Director Camille Cain has issued an order that immediately suspends the transfer of youth from any county facility where staff or youth have tested positive for COVID-19.

At this time, the order includes jails operated by Dallas, Harris, and Bowie counties, as well as the Harris County Juvenile Detention Center.

This order will remain in effect until it is rescinded.
