## Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

August 25, 2021

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 1 youth at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon. This is the agency's first youth case since August 6.
- 1 Youth Development Coach and 1 staff member at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, have tested positive for COVID-19. The first case was confirmed last night, and the second was confirmed this morning.
- TJJD currently has 17 active cases across its facilities (16 staff and 1 youth).
