Update on COVID-19 at TJJJ Facilities

January 13, 2022

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Eighteen youth at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- Fourteen youth at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- One employee at the Gainesville State School tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- Seven employees at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- Two employees at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- Two employees at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- At this time, TJJJ has 170 active cases across its facilities (104 staff and 66 youth).
