## Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

February 1, 2022

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Four youth at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- One youth at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- One staff member at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- Two employees at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- At this time, TJJD has 64 active cases across its facilities (36 staff and 28 youth).
