

**AMENDMENT 2
CON0000483**

The Texas Juvenile Justice Department, hereinafter TJJJ, and Charity Rogers, 1754 Gottier Trace Rd., Paige, Texas 78659, hereinafter Service Provider, acknowledge that they have previously entered into a contract for the provision of services for the period January 1, 2016, through August 31, 2016. This contract is identified as CON0000483.

Both parties wish to continue the relationship that exists without a lapse in services. Service Provider agrees to continue to provide services under the aforementioned existing contract, and TJJJ agrees to continue to use Service Provider's services during the term of this contract.

Service Provider represents and warrants that the individual signing this Amendment is authorized to sign this document on behalf of the Service Provider and to bind the Service Provider under this Amendment.

The parties hereto agree to be bound by the terms of the existing contract, subject to the following changes:

1. Pursuant to Section IV, General Provisions, Article 10: Contract Term, this contract term is hereby amended to extend through **August 31, 2018**.

2. Under Section I, Service Provider, A. Alcohol and Other Drug Treatment (AOD), this contract is being amended to add the following (AOD) services for the Service Provider to provide at Giddings State School:

1. Service Provider shall provide AOD (Moderate Intensity) for six (6) hours per week at Giddings State School, 2261 James Turman Road, P.O. Box 600, Giddings, Texas 78942.
2. Service Provider will use the "Living in Balance: curriculum for the moderate groups".
3. Service Provider will conduct group sessions three (3) times a week, with each session lasting two (2) hours. These services will include four (4) hours of curriculum driven education and two (2) hours of process group.
4. Service Provider will meet one (1) time per month with each youth in the moderate program to establish and review treatment plans and goals and will notify program supervisor or program manager when the youth is being discharged from the program. Each youth will complete an orientation packet and a brief assessment, which includes following and completing TJJJ forms CCF-780 and CCF-784.
5. Service Provider will provide comprehensive notes to the facility Case Manager for inclusion in the youth's treatment file maintained at the TJJJ facility. Service Provider will complete an AOD Assessment (CCF-520ca-AODTP), weekly progress notes (CCF-790), and a discharge summary (CCF-786) for youth in the program.
6. Service Provider will be allotted administrative time to complete individual and group notes/paperwork. This administrative time shall not exceed four (4) hours per month. Additional time will require approval by the Manager of Treatment Services.

3. This contract is also being amended to replace the first sentence in Section I, Service Provider, 6. a to read as follows:

Services will be provided for ten sessions. A request to schedule additional sessions may be approved by the chief local administrator.
