When do I have to convert to JCMS?

- All departments must be on JCMS Conversion schedule by March 2015
- Conversion is a minimum 8-week process
- All departments must be converted to JCMS by August 2015



What happens if I don't convert by August 2015?

- **TJJD will no longer support Caseworker!**
 - No more CW Help Desk calls
 - No CW EDI Support
 - No CW CDA Assistance
- **Caseworker will no longer be updated beyond August 2015**
 - No fixes or code updates
 - No Offense or EDI updates
