Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

November 3, 2020

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 2 youth at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- 1 Youth Development Coach at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.

Since the start of the pandemic, 206 staff members at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 65
Gainesville State School: 13
Giddings State School: 44
McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 40
Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 44

Since the start of the pandemic, 241 youth at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 43
Gainesville State School: 13
Giddings State School: 89
McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 69
Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 27
