Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

November 10, 2020

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 1 Youth Development Coach at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- As of today, TJJD has administered 2,230 COVID-19 tests to youth.
- As a reminder, the TJJD offices will be closed tomorrow in observance of Veterans Day.

Since the start of the pandemic, 209 staff members at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 65
Gainesville State School: 13
Giddings State School: 45
McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 41
Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 45

Since the start of the pandemic, 242 youth at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 44
Gainesville State School: 13
Giddings State School: 89
McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 69
Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 27
