## Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

November 19, 2020

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 1 youth at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- 2 staff members at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- 1 member of the medical staff at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.

Since the start of the pandemic, 216 staff members at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

**Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 67**  
**Gainesville State School: 14**  
**Giddings State School: 45**  
**McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 41**  
**Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 49**

Since the start of the pandemic, 244 youth at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

**Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 44**  
**Gainesville State School: 13**  
**Giddings State School: 89**  
**McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 71**  
**Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 27**
