Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

December 2, 2020

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 1 teacher at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 last night. The employee has not been on campus since November 19, and this is the first positive staff case at Giddings since November 4.

Since the start of the pandemic, 234 staff members at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 71
Gainesville State School: 16
Giddings State School: 46
McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 44
Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 57

Since the start of the pandemic, 246 youth at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 44
Gainesville State School: 13
Giddings State School: 89
McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 72
Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 28
