Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

August 11, 2021

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 1 member of the medical staff at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 yesterday afternoon.
- 1 staff member at a TJJD halfway house tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- 1 Youth Development Coach at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- At this time TJJD has 10 positive cases across its facilities: 8 staff and 2 youth.
