Title 37, Texas Administrative Code, Section 349.200(a) establishes the following:

- Unless expressly prohibited by another standard, the juvenile board, chief administrative officer or facility administrator may submit a request for waiver of any standard adopted by the Texas Juvenile Justice Board.
- If the chief administrative officer or facility administrator submits a request for waiver, the chief administrative officer or facility administrator shall notify in writing the juvenile board simultaneously with submission of the request to the Texas Juvenile Justice Department.
- Waivers granted by Texas Juvenile Justice Department under this section shall not exceed one year. The juvenile board, chief administrative officer, or facility administrator may request one subsequent waiver extension which, if approved, shall not exceed one year.
