Ensuring the safety and security of our youth and staff is our highest priority. In line with recent direction from the Office of the Governor, we are implementing all necessary preventative measures to maintain the well-being of our youth and staff.

Effective immediately, I am waiving provisions under GAP 380.9312 and suspending all in-person visitation to our state operated facilities. This includes visitations by family and volunteers. At this time, we will continue visitation by clergy and religious leaders who are accessing campus specifically to deliver religious services. We are establishing alternative ways to visit, such as virtual visitations and increasing the youth's ability to make phone calls. This suspension of visitation extends to both the state secure facilities and the non-secure halfway houses.

Family liaisons at each facility will be the points of contact for any questions regarding visitation.

This directive will remain in effect until it is rescinded.
