(a) Standard.

Treatment by a nurse is performed pursuant to written standing or direct orders by a provider. Health care practitioners such as nurse practitioners and physician's assistants practice within the limits of applicable laws and regulations.

(b) Procedures.

- (1) Direct orders are defined as written and/or verbal instructions by a provider in prescribing medication or treatment for a specific youth.
- (2) Standing orders are developed and approved by the University of Texas Medical Branch Correctional Managed Care (UTMB) medical director for all Texas Juvenile Justice Department (TJJD) institutions relating to the control of ectoparasitic and infectious diseases.
- (3) Nursing protocols are developed by the UTMB medical director for all TJJD institutions and apply to over-the-counter medications and treatments.
