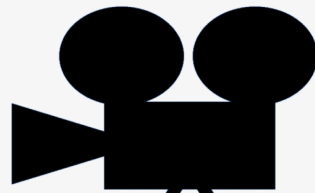

Who is this?

Willfully having or showing a stubborn and determined intention to do as one wants, regardless of the consequences or effects; with the intention of causing harm; deliberately.



A Tough Spot

Woefully is characterized by, expressive of, or causing sorrow or misery; or something is very bad; deplorable.

Becoming a Compass Leader

Being a Leadership Compass requires an acknowledgement that you are recognized as a leader within your organization either by job title or by recognition from your peers. In either circumstance along with that recognition there is a requirement that you accept that people are watching you all the time. What they are looking for is consistent integrity, honesty and credibility.
