AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- We are resuming our regular updates today related to COVID-19. The website has been regularly updated to reflect new cases.
- Please note that the total number of cases listed on the website represent cumulative totals from the start of the pandemic. The timelines of positive cases are also listed, going back to the beginning of the pandemic.
- As of today, TJJD has five active cases across its facilities. All of the cases involve staff members.
