Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

July 27, 2021

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 1 Youth Development Coach at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 yesterday evening.
- 1 Youth Development Coach and 1 staff member at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, have tested positive for COVID-19. The first case was confirmed yesterday evening, and the second was confirmed this afternoon.
- At this time, TJJD has 9 active cases of COVID-19 across its facilities. All of the cases involve staff members.
