AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Two youth at a TJJD halfway house tested positive for COVID-19 this morning. The remaining youth and staff at the facility were tested today with results pending.
- TJJD currently has 7 active cases across its facilities (4 staff and 3 youth).
