## Update on COVID-19 at TJJJ Facilities

January 18, 2022

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Forty-one youth at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- One youth at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- One youth at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- Six employees at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility tested positive for COVID-19 today.
- One employee at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center tested positive for COVID-19 today.
- Six employees at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex tested positive for COVID-19 today.

- At this time, TJJJ has 186 active cases across its facilities (103 youth and 83 staff).
