Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- One youth at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- One teacher at the Gainesville State School tested positive for COVID-19 on Saturday afternoon.
- One staff member at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- At this time, TJJD has 15 active cases across its facilities (9 staff and 6 youth).
