## Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

October 12, 2020

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 2 youth at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- 2 Youth Development Coaches at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19. The first case was confirmed on Saturday, and the second case was confirmed yesterday.
- 1 staff member at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center tested positive for COVID-19 on Saturday.

Since the start of the pandemic, 195 staff members at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

**Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 60**  
**Gainesville State School: 12**  
**Giddings State School: 43**  
**McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 37**  
**Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 43**

Since the start of the pandemic, 225 youth at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

**Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 35**  
**Gainesville State School: 13**  
**Giddings State School: 89**  
**McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 63**  
**Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 26**
