

## **Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities**

October 19, 2020

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 1 youth at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- 1 Youth Development Coach at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 on Friday evening.

Since the start of the pandemic, 197 staff members at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 60 Gainesville State School: 12 Giddings State School: 44

McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 38 Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 43

Since the start of the pandemic, 235 youth at the agency's secure facilities have tested positive for COVID-19:

Evins Regional Juvenile Center: 42 Gainesville State School: 13 Giddings State School: 89

McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility: 64 Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex: 27
