Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

May 21, 2021

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- 1 youth at a TJJD halfway house tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- 1 staff member at a TJJD halfway house tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- Both cases occurred at the same halfway house. The remaining youth and staff have been tested, and all results came back negative.
- At this time, TJJD has three active cases of COVID-19 across its facilities: 2 staff and 1 youth.
