TJJD Youth Escapes From Custody

The 16-year-old male was undergoing treatment at Dell Children's Medical Center, in Austin

June 14, 2021

AUSTIN—Erik Robinson, a 16-year-old from Corpus Christi, escaped from custody this evening at approximately 6:40 p.m. from Dell Children's Medical Center, in Austin (4900 Mueller Boulevard). Robinson had been outside for supervised recreation when he climbed a wall and ran. Officers from the Inspector General's staff immediately notified law enforcement and issued a BOLO notification.

Robinson is a white male with blond hair and blue eyes. He is 5 feet 8 inches tall and weighs approximately 150 pounds. He has scars on his right wrist, his left hand, both knees, and his back. He was last seen wearing a gray Adidas sweat shirt and gray sweat pants. While TJJD typically does not reveal the identities of youth, in situations such as an escape the agency does so to help ensure public safety and the safety of the youth.

Residents in the area near Dell Children's and in Corpus Christi are asked to remain vigilant. If they see anyone who matches Robinson's description, do not engage him but please call 9-1-1.
