## **TJJD Youth Returns Safely to Custody**

**Erik Robinson was apprehended in his hometown of Corpus Christi without incident**

AUSTIN—Erik Robinson, a 16-year-old from Corpus Christi who had escaped on June 14, was located in his hometown today and safely returned to custody. Robinson had been undergoing treatment at Dell Children’s Medical Center, in Austin, when he escaped while he was outside for supervised recreation. TJJD’s Office of the Inspector General was able to locate Robinson based on its ongoing investigation, and he was taken into custody by the Corpus Christi Police Department.

“I am grateful that this situation has ended safely and peacefully,” said Camille Cain, the Executive Director of TJJD. “I want to extend my sincere appreciation to TJJD’s Office of the Inspector General and the officers of the Corpus Christi Police Department for their diligent and professional work in locating and returning Erik Robinson to custody.”
