Update on COVID-19 at TJJJ Facilities

August 31, 2021

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- One member of the medical staff at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- One staff member at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- TJJJ currently has 29 active cases across its facilities (26 staff and 3 youth).
