## Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

September 7, 2021

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Three youth at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, have tested positive for COVID-19. Two cases were confirmed over the holiday weekend, and the third case was confirmed this morning.
- Three employees at Ron Jackson tested positive for COVID-19 over the holiday weekend.
- Campus-wide testing at Ron Jackson will be held on Thursday.
- One staff member at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- TJJD currently has 22 active cases across its facilities (19 staff and 3 youth).
