## Update on COVID-19 at TJJJ Facilities

November 3, 2021

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- One youth at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- One staff member at a TJJJ halfway house tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- This marks the first youth case since October 28 and the first staff case since October 22.
- TJJJ currently has 10 active cases across its facilities (8 youth and 2 staff).
