Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

January 12, 2022

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Three youth at a halfway house tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- Ten youth at the Gainesville State School tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- Thirteen youth at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- Four employees at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- Seven employees at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- Two employees at the Giddings State School have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- Two employees at halfway houses have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- One employee at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- Two employees at the Gainesville State School tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- At this time, TJJD has 186 active cases across its facilities (112 staff and 74 youth).
