Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

January 19, 2022

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Two youth at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- Two employees at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- Three employees at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 today.
- Two employees at the Gainesville State School tested positive for COVID-19 today.
- Two employees at TJJD halfway houses tested positive for COVID-19 today.
- At this time, TJJD has 179 active cases across its facilities (97 youth and 82 staff).
