Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

January 20, 2022

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Six youth at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- Four youth at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- Two employees at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- Two employees at Ron Jackson tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- Two employees at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- One employee at the Gainesville State School tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- At this time, TJJD has 172 active cases across its facilities (89 youth and 83 staff).
