## Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

January 25, 2022

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Ten youth at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility, in Mart, have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- One youth at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 last night.
- Two employees at the Gainesville State School have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- Four employees at the Giddings State School have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- Three employees at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- One employee at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Facility tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- One employee at a halfway house tested positive for COVID-19 this afternoon.
- At this time, TJJD has 85 active cases across its facilities (54 staff and 31 youth).
