Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Three youth at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- Two staff members at the Giddings State School have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 24 hours.
- One staff member at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- At this time, TJJD has 16 active cases across its facilities (8 staff and 8 youth).
