Update on COVID-19 at TJJJ Facilities

February 11, 2022

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Three youth at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 yesterday evening.
- One youth at the Ron Jackson State Juvenile Correctional Complex, in Brownwood, tested positive for COVID-19 yesterday evening.
- Two youth at the Giddings State School tested positive for COVID-19 this morning.
- At this time, TJJJ has 19 active cases across its facilities (5 staff and 14 youth).
