Update on COVID-19 at TJJD Facilities

February 14, 2022

AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- Two youth at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 Friday night.
- Three staff members at the Giddings State School have tested positive for COVID-19 since Friday night.
- One staff member at the McLennan County State Juvenile Correctional Center, in Mart, tested positive for COVID-19 yesterday afternoon.
- At this time, TJJD has 20 active cases across its facilities (6 staff and 14 youth).
