AUSTIN—The Texas Juvenile Justice Department provided the following updates today related to COVID-19:

- One youth at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center, in Edinburg, tested positive for COVID-19 Friday night.
- One staff member at the Evins Regional Juvenile Center tested positive for COVID-19 yesterday afternoon.
- At this time, TJJD has 6 active cases across its facilities (2 staff and 4 youth).
