RULE

(a) **Purpose.**

This rule establishes a program to provide youth with opportunities for career and technology education.

(b) **General Provisions.**

- (1) Upon admission to TJJD, each youth completes a vocational assessment. The results of the assessment may be considered when determining appropriate career and technology education program placement for the youth.
- (2) Youth enrolled in a career and technology education program complete a course in which they explore an individual career path.
- (3) Youth who are academically ready and are in compliance with behavioral expectations have an opportunity to enroll in career and technology education courses in conjunction with their academic courses.
- (4) Factors such as age, interest, safety, and basic literacy are considered when placing youth in advanced career and technology education courses.
- (5) TJJD regularly reviews career and technology training options to determine their relevance to employment opportunities in the community.
- (6) TJJD uses business, industry, and community resources in developing academic and vocational education programs for selected youth.
