| American Correctional Association (ACA) | Credentialing association |
| Emergency Telephone Number | 911 |
| First Aid | Emergency intervention provided onsite |
| Health Services Administrator (HSA) | Institutional nurse manager in charge of managing health services at halfway houses. HSA may also fulfill nurse's role during the monthly visit if deemed necessary. |
| Health Services Management System | Procedure for the management, communication, and documentation of current, pending, or inactive health-related activities |
| Human Services Specialist (HSS) | Staff assigned to coordinate youth's health needs at halfway houses |
| Juvenile Correctional Officer (JCO) | Halfway house staff assigned to provide direct care of youth |
| Medical Director | Texas Youth Commission or UTMB Correctional Managed Care Youth Services physician administrator |
| Medication Administration Record (MAR) | Form used to document administration of medication to assigned youth as ordered by the physician |
| Nurse | The registered nurse assigned to provide case management services for the halfway house |
| Medical Provider | Medical doctor or mid-level practitioner (nurse practitioner or physician assistant) |
| PRS (Pharmacy Replacement System) | The electronic system used for documenting administration of medication |
| Superintendent | Person responsible for local administration and management of halfway house operations |
| Utilization Review (UR) | The UTMB Correctional Managed Care department responsible for authorizing/providing approval for specialty, emergency, and local off-site medical/dental care |
| UTMB Correctional Managed Care (CMC) | The designated health authority contracted by the Texas Youth Commission to provide oversight of medical, dental, and psychiatric services to youth residing in TYC-operated halfway houses |
| Youth | TYC-operated halfway house resident |
