**Standard.**

- (1) Each institution operates by the procedures outlined in this manual.
  - (2) Each TJJD medical facility has a designated health authority responsible for the operation of the health care delivery system. The designated health authority for each institution is the health services administrator, who must be a registered nurse. The health services administrator is authorized and responsible for making decisions about the deployment of health resources and the day-to-day operations of the health services program. Final clinical judgments at the institution rest with the designated physician.
  - (3) The facility health authority's roles and responsibilities are specified in a written job description and maintained at the facility and the office of the TJJD medical director.
