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As used in the Institution Health Services Procedure Manual, the following terms have the following meanings, unless otherwise defined in a procedure.

RN Clinical Case Manager	The RN clinical case manager is responsible for coordinating the care of a specified group of youth.
EMR	Electronic Medical Record.
TJJD Health Authority	The TJJD medical director is designated as the agency's health authority. The TJJD medical director delegates operational responsibility to the UTMB medical director. The UTMB medical director designates a local health authority for each facility.
Health-Trained Staff Member	A TJJD staff member who is trained to provide a specific health care service under the direction of a qualified health care professional.
Intra-system Transfer	Transfer to a TJJD-operated residential facility from a residential facility operated by TJJD.
Facility Health Authority	The health services administrator (HSA).
Youth Health Services Leadership Council (YHSLC)/Continuous Quality Improvement Committee (CQI)	TJJD and UTMB staff responsible for provision and oversight of health care services to youth. Members of the council are appointed by the TJJD and UTMB medical directors.
Mental Health Professional	An individual who is a doctoral-level psychologist, masters-level mental health specialist, licensed professional counselor, licensed psychological associate, or a licensed social worker.
Provider	A Texas-licensed medical doctor or doctor of osteopathy or Texas-licensed nurse practitioner or physician assistant.
TJJD	Texas Juvenile Justice Department
UTMB	University of Texas Medical Branch - Correctional Managed Care Youth Services.
