

JCMS – Juvenile Banner Photo

Below are the 'best practices' for juvenile photos uploaded to the JCMS Banner:

- The photo should include the juvenile's head and shoulders with shoulders square to the camera.
- The photo should be in color and taken on a gray or neutral background and should not contain shadows.
- Head coverings, including hats and scarves, should not be worn. The full face and ears should be displayed.
- When possible, the juvenile's hair should be moved to reveal the full face and ears.
- For subjects who normally wear eyeglasses, every effort should be made to capture the photo with the glasses on. The wearing of eye patches is allowed only for medical reasons.
- The expression should be neutral (non-smiling) with both eyes open normally (i.e. not wide-open), and mouth closed.
