Subject: Due Process Hearings and EM Tampering; Other Violations
Date: March 28, 2023

Effective immediately, staff will seek a Level I hearing (for youth on parole) or a Level II hearing for return to high restriction (for youth in medium-restriction facilities who are not on parole status) if a youth has electronic monitoring (EM) as a condition of parole or placement and has allegedly tampered with the electronic monitoring equipment.

Staff must continue to seek a parole revocation hearing on a TJJJ parolee who has allegedly engaged in any of the following types of parole violations, whether or not the youth has been charged with a criminal offense:

- Violent conduct.
- Conduct involving a weapon.
- Conduct that is related to gang involvement or gang activity.
