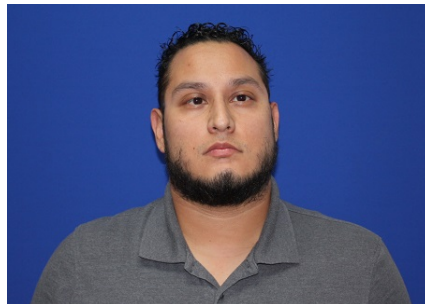
## **PUBLIC INFORMATION ARREST SUMMARY**

On August 3, 2021, Deputy Inspector Generals with the Office of Inspector General at the Texas Juvenile Justice Department obtained an arrest warrant for Alvaro Alvarado, 35 years of age, a TJJD employee for Official Oppression. The alleged offense is a Class A Misdemeanor under Texas Penal Code 39.03, which is punishable up to a \$4,000 fine and a term of imprisonment in jail up to one (1) year. Deputy Inspector Generals arrested Alvarado on this warrant and booked him into the Hidalgo County Jail.

These arrest warrants emanated from an investigation conducted by the Inspector General's Office on an incident that occurred in May of 2021. Alvarado, while employed by TJJD, subjected a TJJD offender to mistreatment by allowing other TJJD offenders to assault him. This case will be forwarded to the Special Prosecution Unit for consideration.

The Office of the Inspector General is statutorily responsible to investigate criminal allegations involving TJJD youth, TJJD employees, or T.J.J.D. facilities.
