## PUBLIC INFORMATION CONVICTION SUMMARY

---

On March 24, 2022, the Office of Inspector General (OIG) at the Texas Juvenile Justice Department (TJJD) received notice that former contract care employee **Caylie Rae Martin (23)** accepted a plea agreement and plea of guilty to Texas Penal Code chapter 39.04, Violation of Rights of a Person in Custody by engaging in improper sexual activity. **Caylie Rae Martin** was sentenced to 10 years deferred adjudication in the 35<sup>th</sup> District Court in Brown County, Texas. This case was investigated by the Office of Inspector General and prosecuted by the Brown County District Attorney's office.

**Caylie Rae Martin**, a Youth Care Worker at True Core Behavioral Solutions (TCBS), a TJJD contract care facility, was alleged to have engaged in sexual intercourse with a 17 year old male county committed juvenile offender. The offense took place in October of 2019 while the victim was in the custody of TCBS. TCBS changed ownership in June 2020 and is now operated by Rite of Passage-The Oaks. In November 2019, **Caylie Rae Martin** was previously arrested by Deputy Inspectors for the alleged offense.

The Office of the Inspector General is statutorily responsible to investigate criminal allegations involving TJJD juveniles, TJJD employees, or TJJD facilities, contractors, or programs.
